

FRONT RANGE ASSISTED LIVING FACILITY SCHOLARSHIP

Front Range Assisted Living has established a \$1,000 scholarship for students displaying academic excellence, volunteer work in the community (most particularly with the elderly), and school activity/organization involvement. The scholarship will be awarded annually to a deserving senior from Fairfield High School. (The scholarship amount may vary from year to year.)

Criteria:

- **Graduating Senior at Fairfield High School**
- **Attending a 2 year, 4 year college or trade school**
- **Service to the school and community - most importantly with the elderly**
- **Academic achievement**

Selection:

Students must complete the following application, write a personal essay (300+ words), attach three letters of recommendation from individuals outside their own family, and attach an official transcript. Applications will be reviewed by Front Range Assisted Living and Fairfield High School faculty as deemed necessary.

Award:

The scholarship will be awarded annually at Class Night and be presented by a Front Range Assisted Living representative.
