

Gertrude Weishaar

Memorial Scholarship

The Fairfield Junior Women have created a scholarship fund in memory of longtime teacher and friend, Gertrude Weishaar. Gertrude Weishaar served the students at Fairfield High School and the state of Montana for 44 years as the math and science teacher. The scholarship will awarded annually to a deserving student from Fairfield High School and will be managed through the Fairfield Scholarship Trust Fund. The scholarship amount may vary from year to year.

Criteria:

1. Graduating Senior at Fairfield High School
2. Attending a 2 year, 4 year college or trade school
3. Preference will be given to students pursuing a field in math and science
4. Service to the school and community
5. Has shown academic effort

Selection:

Students must complete the following application, write a personal statement and include three letters of recommendation as well as an official transcript. Applications must be turned in by May 1st to the high school counselor. Applications will be reviewed by the Fairfield Junior Women's scholarship committee.

Award:

The scholarship will be awarded annually at Class Night and be presented by a Fairfield Junior Women's club member. In order to receive the scholarship the recipient must show proof of enrollment as a full time student and a receipt showing financial commitment . This proof must be submitted to the scholarship trust fund administrator at the high school office.
