

Region II Montana Association of Secondary School Principals (MASSP) Scholarship

Purpose

The Region II Montana Association of Secondary Principal's Scholarship Program (MASSP) awards two \$500 scholarships to college-bound high school seniors based on demonstrated academic achievement, extra-curricular activities, and school and community service.

Applicant Qualifications

- Graduating senior at a Region II MASSP high school with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Graduating senior who attends a school with a principal that is an MASSP member in good standing at the professional membership level. Note: Children of MASSP staff or members of the selection committee are not eligible.
- Graduating senior who will be enrolled as a full-time student (at least 12 credits per semester/trimester) at a public community/junior college, four-year degree-granting institution, or vocational training institution that grants a degree, certification or license.

Application Process

Applicants must complete ALL sections of the application form. Do not put materials in any type of folder or portfolio, as it will be discarded. In addition, do not include any unnecessary documents with the form, such as photographs, news clippings or IRS/income tax information, as they will be disregarded. The application form and supporting documents must be in MASSP's possession no later than the close of business on Friday, April 28, 2017.

Awards

Scholarship Recipients can be expected to be notified of their application by Mid-May. Recipients may only use the funds toward tuition and room/board costs. Payment will be made directly to the student's account at his/her education institution in August.
