STEVE DIEDRICH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Each year a scholarship will be awarded to a deserving senior in memory of Steven Diedrich. Steve was the Industrial Arts/Auto Mechanics teacher at F.H.S. for 18 years. He was a person of highest integrity and honesty. He always encouraged students to pursue post-secondary learning. In Steve's memory the staff at Fairfield Public Schools will present annually a one year non-renewable scholarship in his memory to a student who exemplifies those qualities and values that Steve tried to instill in his students.

Criteria:

Award winner must be:

- 1. A graduating senior at FHS
- 2. An individual who needs encouragement to pursue post-secondary education
- 3. Have a minimum GPA of 2.0
- 4. Must exemplify the qualities of honesty, integrity, perseverance and determination

Application Procedure

Submit an application to the scholarship committee describing your goals and needs by May 1st.

Method of Selection

Applications will go to a committee made up of Certified and Classified staff members. The committee will choose five applicants to be voted on by the staff by secret ballot. An alternate will be chosen in case the winning applicant does not go onto post-secondary schooling.

Method of Assessment

Each staff member will be assessed a \$20.00 scholarship fee each year. Money will be deducted from employee's first paycheck in May unless paid ahead of time.

Method of Awarding

The award will be made payable to the student and their post-secondary school upon notification to F.H.S. that he/she is taking a minimum of nine (9) credits.

NOTE: It is the student's responsibility to notify Fairfield School of his/her college attendance status by November 1st during fall semester and March 15th during spring semester or forfeit his/her scholarship for that semester.

One half of the scholarship amount will be awarded each semester. The student <u>must</u> <u>maintain</u> a cumulative G.P.A. of 2.0 in order to receive the second half of the scholarship.
